Dunnerholme Golf Club Ltd - Ride-on Buggy Safety Policy

Members and visitors of the Dunnerholme Golf Club Ltd are asked to read the following important information regarding the health and safety of ride-on golf buggies and their use on the course and associated areas:

The Club has a duty of care to all users of the golf course.

The topography of certain areas of the course is such that caution, and prudence must be shown by the user of a ride-on buggy. Therefore, it is unacceptable to take a ride-on buggy up the Dunnerholme Rock to the 7th elevated tee, via the front path—use the path to the rear of the Cottages. It is also necessary for the Club to provide adequately safe means of access for all golfers, therefore tee area 7B is provided. Moreover, the Club must ensure the safety of golfers who do not wish to use ride-on buggies, but who might be at risk from a mechanically defective ride-on buggy or its careless use.

The duty of care also applies to members of the public using the rights of way. To assist the safe employment of ride-on buggies, all potential users shall comply with the following conditions:

- **1.** Ride-on buggies must be operated with the utmost courtesy, care and consideration for the safety and convenience of pedestrians. Pedestrians must be always afforded the right of way.
- **2.** Ride-on buggies must be operated and parked in such manner that they do not impede or interfere with normal or vehicular flow on roadways or paths.
- **3.** Ride-on buggy operators will be responsible for the security of ignition keys for the period that the buggy is on all areas owned by the Club.
- **4.** The Dunnerholme Golf Club Ltd has no responsibility for ensuring the safe operation of ride-on buggies on or beyond the confines of the course and carpark, other than those operated by their servants or agents. The Club will accept no responsibility for any loss or damage caused to any property other than that arising from the negligent use of a ride-on buggy by their servants or agents.
- **5.** No ride-on buggy to be operated more than 10mph per hour. All speed limits must be observed.
- 6. Ride-on buggies may be used between dawn and dusk.
- **7.** Ride-on buggies shall be used in compliance with common "rules of the road", regardless of whether ride-on buggies are operated on paths or roadways.
- **8.** The consumption of alcohol and/or the improper use of drugs when using the ride-on buggy is forbidden.
- **9.** Employees or Officers of the Dunnerholme Golf Club Ltd have the authority to immediately prohibit an individual from using or being carried on a ride-on buggy. Application for reinstatement of permission can only be made to the Club Council.

10. From time to time, the Club staff may determine that the state of the course or weather is such that safety on, or condition of the course may be unacceptably compromised if a ride-on buggy is used. This might apply to the whole or just part of the course. Potentially unsuitable conditions include water logging, frost, snow, etc. Where such conditions arise, the Club will review the situation on at least a daily basis.

KNOW THE CONTROLS AND HOW TO USE THEM

- 1.Ignition switch and immobiliser key
- 2. Accelerator
- 3. Footbrake
- 4. Parking brake—set the brake before leaving the ride-on buggy
- 5. Reversing control

KNOW YOUR DRIVING CONDITIONS

Ride-on buggies can only be used for the number of occupants it was designed to carry and by those authorised to do so.

Ride-on buggies must not be used on areas of the course where access is denied.

The vehicle must not be driven up and down the course when looking for golf balls.

The vehicle must not be used on tees, greens or slopes leading up to them.

The vehicle must not be within 5 metres of, or on, slopes leading to any ditches or becks (except when crossing designated bridges).

The vehicle must not enter the buggy/trolley exclusion zones around greens.

Always consider the terrain, existing vehicular and pedestrian traffic conditions, as well as environmental factors that may affect your ability to operate the vehicle safely.

Drive the vehicle only as fast as the terrain and safety considerations allow.

To avoid tipping over, drive the buggies straight up and down the slopes.

Slow down before corners.

All turns must be executed at reduced speeds.

Avoid sudden stops or changes of direction that may result in loss of control.

PROBLEMS

- 1. Only cross becks/ditches by use of bridges.
- 2. Do not make unnecessary climbs, such as to the1st tee or 6th green via front path.
- 3. Take care when using the rear access road at the Dunnerholme cottages.

Buggies booked but not used, will be charged for.

Dunnerholme Golf Club advise all buggy users to have adequate personal insurance to protect themselves against such liability.

Buggies will be collected from the Buggy Park.

Strictly only maximum two persons will travel on the buggy. Wardens will be patrolling the course and anyone not observing this rule will be required to immediately leave the course without refund.

The buggy user acknowledges full responsibility of this buggy while in your use and accept full liability for any damage or injury caused to property or public, including costs associated with repairing damage caused to this buggy during the hire period.

The buggy user has checked the buggy before use, and it is free of major damage or faults.

The buggy user is responsible for reporting any existing damage or faults to Greens Staff before use/during use, otherwise he/she may be liable for the cost of repairs.

Buggies must be returned to the Buggy Park.
